National Entlebucher Mountain Dog Association Championship Program Rules

Section I – Eligibility

Dog must be a pure bred Entlebucher Mountain Dog

Dog must be registered with NEMDA and have a NEMDA Registration number

Section II – Age

Dog/Bitches must be six months of age, or older to earn points toward a Championship.

Section III – Points

Fifteen (15) points are required to earn a NEMDA Championship. Points can only be earned at NEMDA Shows, or at a venue that recognized the Entlebucher Mountain Dog, and awards points toward a Championship title. Placement in Puppy or Fun Matches will not count toward a NEMDA Championship.

Points from two (2) ‘majors’ earned under two different judges are required as part of the accrued 15 points needed to earn a Championship title

Points are earned by Winners Dog/Bitch only. **Best of Breed will receive points for defeating the dog/bitch of opposite sex if the point total is greater.

1 dog defeated – earn 1 point

2 dogs defeated – earn 2 points

3 dogs defeated – earn 3 points (major)

4 dogs defeated – earn 4 points (major)

5 dogs defeated – earn 5 points (major)

**** No more than 5 points may be earned in any given Show.**

Section IV – NEMDA Shows

Two shows will be held at Entlefest each year. The winner of each Show will compete for an overall ‘Best of Specialty’ winner.

Classes will be as follows:

6 to 9 months Puppy Dog

9 to 12 months Puppy Dog

Bred by Exhibitor

Open Dog

Winners Dog

6 to 9 months Puppy Bitch

9 to 12 months Puppy Bitch

Section V – Sweepstakes

A Sweepstakes Match will be held in conjunction with the Conformation Show at Entlefest each year for puppies, neutered and spayed dogs and bitches, and veterans. No points will be awarded – Ribbons only

Classes will be as follows:

3 to 6 month puppy dog

Open Dog (neutered)

Veteran Dog (8 years and older)

Stud Dog and two of his get

**3 to 6 month puppy bitch
Open Bitch (spayed)
Veteran Bitch (8 years and older)
Brood Bitch and two of her produce**

Section VI – Judges

The Show Committee will choose Judges.

Choice of judges will be based on their knowledge and experience with the Entlebucher breed.

The NEMDA Secretary or an appointed Show Steward will handle contracts and correspondence with the judges.

Section VII – Participants and Handlers

An Entlebucher can be handled in the ring by his/her owner or any other handler of the owner's choice except in Bred by Exhibitor. Only the Breeder/owner may handle a puppy or adult in the Bred by Exhibitor Class.

In Sweepstakes only the breeder, owner, Stud Dog owner, or a member of their immediate family may show the dog.

NEMDA Board Members, Show Committee members, and Entlefest Chair and Committee members may participate in any NEMDA sponsored Show, except in the case that correspondence with one of the judges has taken place by any of the above within six months of the date of Show.

Section VIII – Disqualifications

Any disqualification listed in the Breed Standard.

Any Entlebucher that does not meet the qualifications listed in Section I - Eligibility

At the discretion of the Judge, any Entlebucher that exhibits extreme aggression or shyness in the Ring may be disqualified.

At the discretion of the Show Committee, any Entlebucher that shows extreme aggression and is considered a hazard will be asked to leave the Show grounds, such action will result in loss of points earned at the Show the date of the incident.

Any owner deemed by the Committee, Ring Steward, or Judge to exhibit poor sportsmanship will be excused and will forfeit any awards received that day.

Three instances will result in permanent disqualification.

****An owner has the right to appeal, but the findings of the Committee are final.**
